ORDERING OF FLAGS AT HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS, on Saturday, January 8, 2011, a gunman senselessly opened fire on public officials and innocent bystanders in Tucson, Arizona, which, according to the *Arizona Republic*, killed six and injured thirteen;


WHEREAS, the people of Arizona and the people of Nevada have a long and rich tradition of shared values, economic ties, and friendship, and it is right and proper that we show our respect and solidarity to our neighbors; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada;"



NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:

As a mark of respect for the memory of U.S. District Judge John Roll, Christina Taylor Green, Dorothy Morris, Phyllis Schneck, Dorwan Stoddard, and Gabe Zimmerman in the Arizona shooting, the flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and upon all state public buildings and grounds, starting today, Monday, January 10, 2011, until sunset on Wednesday, January 12, 2011.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Nevada to be affixed at the State Capitol in Carson City, this tenth day of January, in the year two thousand eleven.
