



**Executive Order 2011-05**

**ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF**

*WHEREAS*, on January 26, 2011, Fifth Judicial District Court Judge John P. Davis passed away;

*WHEREAS*, Judge Davis spent twenty years serving the people of the state of Nevada as a District Court judge;

*WHEREAS*, it is appropriate to honor Judge Davis's devotion to public service and his contribution to our state; and

*WHEREAS*, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

*NOW, THEREFORE*, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:

The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all State public buildings and grounds starting today, Thursday, January 27, 2011, until sunset on Friday, January 28, 2011.
