ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS, Spc. Brian Tabada of Las Vegas, Nevada served his State and country honorably in Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan while fighting with the 1st Battalion, 327th Infantry Regiment, 1st Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division;

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2011, Spc. Tabada made the ultimate sacrifice in defense of freedom on behalf of the people of this State on a battlefield in Afghanistan;


WHEREAS, it is right to honor the life, service and sacrifice of Spc. Tabada; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:

The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol starting today, Tuesday, March 1, 2011, until sunset on Wednesday, March 2, 2011.
