ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS, today, March 15, 2011, Army Corporal Frank W. Buckles, the last surviving American veteran of World War I will be interred;

WHEREAS, Corporal Buckles and the entire generation of American veterans of World War I deserve to be remembered; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:

The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all State public buildings and grounds today, Tuesday, March 15, 2011, until sunset.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Nevada to be affixed at the State Capitol in Carson City, this fifteenth day of March, in the year two thousand eleven.
