



Executive Order 2011-10  
ESTABLISHING THE GUINN ROOM

*WHEREAS*, the late Governor Kenny C. Guinn served the people of the state of Nevada with honor and distinction;

*WHEREAS*, Governor Guinn's commitment to the state included serving as Superintendent of the Clark County School District, Interim President of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, and Governor of the State of Nevada;

*WHEREAS*, Governor Guinn's accomplishments as Governor included the establishment of the Guinn Millennium Scholarship, the creation of the Nevada Senior Rx Program and the promotion of Nevada Check-Up for needy children;

*WHEREAS*, Governor Guinn's service as Governor was recognized by *Time* magazine, which named him one of the five best Governors in America;

*WHEREAS*, in 2005, Governor Guinn oversaw completion of the renovation of the Capitol Annex;

*WHEREAS*, Nevada Revised Statutes 331.130 gives the Chief of the Buildings and Grounds Division of the Department of Administration authority over the maintenance and management of the Capitol Annex; and

*WHEREAS*, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

*NOW, THEREFORE*, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. The Capitol Annex media room is hereby renamed the Guinn Room, in honor of Governor Kenny C. Guinn and his service to the state.
2. The Chief of the Buildings and Grounds Division of the Department of Administration is hereby directed to make the renaming permanent through the erecting of signage befitting its purpose.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Nevada to be affixed at the State Capitol in Carson City, this twelfth day of April, in the year two thousand eleven.
