ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF**

*WHEREAS*, on Saturday, April 16, 2011, University of Nevada, Reno President Milton Glick passed away unexpectedly;

*WHEREAS*, President Glick served with distinction as the 15<sup>th</sup> President of the University of Nevada, Reno;

*WHEREAS*, President Glick's tenure was marked with numerous achievements, including overseeing important capital projects such as the Joe Crowley Student Union, the Mathewson-IGT Knowledge Center and the Davidson Math and Science Center;

*WHEREAS*, President Glick ushered in a period of significant growth in the University's student body, recruiting a record number of National Merit Scholars and Presidential Scholars;


*WHEREAS*, President Glick further succeeded in expanding student enrollment, access to scholarship opportunities, retention and diversity; and

*WHEREAS*, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

*NOW, THEREFORE*, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:

The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all State public buildings and grounds Thursday, April 21, 2011, until sunset.
