



**Executive Order 2011-14**

**ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF**

*WHEREAS*, on Tuesday, September 6, 2011, a gunman opened fire on civilians and uniformed personnel of the Nevada National Guard in a restaurant in Carson City, Nevada;

*WHEREAS*, to this point this senseless act of violence has resulted in the deaths of two members of the National Guard, both of whom were in the restaurant in connection with their official duties;

*WHEREAS*, in addition to those killed, several others were injured;

*WHEREAS*, it is incumbent upon the State to honor the victims of this tragedy; and

*WHEREAS*, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

*NOW, THEREFORE*, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada and the laws of the United States, it is hereby ordered as follows:


The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all State public buildings and grounds starting Tuesday, September 6, 2011, and ending at sundown on Friday, September 9, 2011.
