



**Executive Order 2011-15
AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 2011-14**

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, September 6, 2011, I signed Executive Order 2011-14 ordering that the flags of the United States and the State of Nevada be lowered to half-staff in the wake of the shooting in Carson City, Nevada;

WHEREAS, the shooting has claimed the lives of four people and injured seven others;

WHEREAS, those killed include Major Heath Kelly, Sergeant First Class Miranda McElhiny, Sergeant First Class Christian Riege and Florence Donovan-Gunderson;

WHEREAS, funeral and memorial services are scheduled to be held in memory of those members of the National Guard killed as a result of the shooting on September 10 and 11, 2011;

WHEREAS, Sunday September 11, 2011, is Patriot Day; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada and the laws of the United States, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Executive Order 2011-14 is amended to read as follows:


The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all State public buildings and grounds starting Tuesday, September 6, 2011, and ending at sundown on Sunday, September 11, 2011.
