



Executive Order 2011-24

**AMENDING THE MAY 25, 2010 EXECUTIVE ORDER ESTABLISHING
THE NEVADA CRIME COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Nevada Crime Commission ("Commission") was created by Executive Order on May 25, 2010 to act as an advisory body to the Governor on combating crime;

WHEREAS, the July 12, 2011 Final Report of the Governor's Sunset Task Force recommends that an Executive Order be issued to continue the Commission, require periodic reporting to the Governor and establish an expiration date; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, I hereby direct and order:


The Executive Order establishing the Commission, signed May 25, 2010, is amended as follows:

1. The Commission shall deliver a report to the Governor on or before June 30 and December 31 each year detailing the activities of the Commission. All records documenting the Commission's activities shall be retained and transferred to the State Archives for permanent retention in accordance with the State record retention policy.
2. The Commission may establish procedural bylaws to aid it in the performance of its duties.
3. The Commission may form subcommittees comprised of members of the Commission to aid it in the performance of its duties.
4. The Commission shall cease to exist on July 1, 2015.

In all other respects, the Executive Order establishing the Commission remains unchanged.




