



**Executive Order 2011-30
ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF**

WHEREAS, this date marks the 70th anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, in 1941.

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for the People of Nevada to pause in prayer and reflection on this date, in remembrance of the nearly 2,400 souls lost at Pearl Harbor and the countless other Veterans and Civilians who gave their life in service to their country in the War that followed.

WHEREAS, the battleship USS Nevada holds a special place in the annals of history for the role played by its crew on that fateful date.


WHEREAS, many Nevadans sacrificed during World War II and they are owed the thanks of a grateful Nation.

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."



NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:

The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all State public buildings and grounds today, Wednesday, December 7, 2011, until sunset.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Nevada to be affixed at the State Capitol in Carson City, this seventh day of December, in the year two thousand eleven.
