



Executive Order 2011-32

ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS, on December 20, 2011, Second Judicial District Court Judge Robert H. Perry passed away;

WHEREAS, Judge Perry served as a District Court from 2005 to the time of his death, serving the people of the state with distinction;

WHEREAS, earlier in his career, Judge Perry served as an investigator and prosecutor with the Washoe County District Attorney's Office;


WHEREAS, Judge Perry's career was marked by distinction, having been elected to the American College of Trial Lawyers and the American Board of Trial Advocates, being listed in Best Lawyers in America and having been selected as Trial Lawyer of the Year for the State of Nevada in 2004; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:

The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all State public buildings and grounds Thursday, December 22, 2011, until sunset.
