



Executive Order 2012-03

ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS, Marine Corporal Jon-Luke Bateman, age 22, was killed on Sunday, January 15, while on duty in Afghanistan with the 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines out of Camp Pendleton, California;

WHEREAS, Corporal Bateman, a graduate of Pahrump Valley High School, died while attempting to assist a fellow Marine in a time of emergency; and


WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:

The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all State public buildings and grounds on Monday, January 23, 2012, until sunset.




