



Executive Order 2012-05

ELIMINATING THE SAGE IMPLEMENTATION BLUE-RIBBON PANEL

WHEREAS, the Sunset Task Force ("Task Force") was established by Executive Order on April 7, 2011, to review the necessity of existing nonstatutory Executive Branch advisory bodies;

WHEREAS, the Task Force was charged with completing a review of existing Executive Branch advisory bodies including the following elements: identification of all entities created by previous governors' executive orders or by Executive Branch agency, department and division administrators; evaluation of each entity's mission and necessity for continuation, using Chapter 232B of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS") as a guideline; determination of the costs incurred or savings realized by continuing or terminating each entity; and a determination of a deadline by which ongoing entities should be re-evaluated;

WHEREAS, the Task Force issued its final report on July 12, 2011, including a recommendation to discontinue certain Executive Branch advisory bodies;

WHEREAS, I have reviewed the Task Force's final report and agree with its recommendation regarding the discontinuation of the advisory bodies identified therein; and


WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, I hereby direct and order:

1. Consistent with the recommendation of the Task Force, the SAGE Implementation Blue-Ribbon Panel is eliminated.
2. To the extent this order conflicts with any previous executive order, this order controls.




