**ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF**

**WHEREAS**, on March 22, 2012, Tenth Judicial District Court Judge David A. Huff passed away;

**WHEREAS**, Judge Huff served with distinction as a district court judge in our state for fifteen years;

**WHEREAS**, Judge Huff's career also included service to his country in the Vietnam War, being awarded the Navy Commendation Medal, and serving with the United States Navy Judge Advocate General;


**WHEREAS**, Judge Huff's commitment to his community was reflected not only in his judicial service but in his membership in the Churchill County Museum Association, the Churchill County Arts Council, the Fallon Elks Lodge and the Fallon Rotary; and

**WHEREAS**, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."


**NOW, THEREFORE**, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:
