



**Executive Order 2012-10**

**ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF**

*WHEREAS*, law enforcement officers throughout our state serve the citizens of Nevada with honor and distinction on a daily basis;

*WHEREAS*, the week of May 1, 2012 has been designated as National Police Week;

*WHEREAS*, on Thursday, May 3, 2012, in conjunction with National Police Week, the 15th Annual Nevada Law Enforcement Officers Memorial ceremony will be held on the Capitol grounds in Carson City;


*WHEREAS*, the service will honor the 120 Nevada Peace Officers that have been killed in the line of duty, including Deputy Sheriff Jack D. London of the Clark County Sheriff's Office, Special Agent Don C. Ware of the U.S. DEA Las Vegas Office, and Correctional Officer Tracy A. Hardin of the Nevada Department of Corrections; and

*WHEREAS*, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."


*NOW, THEREFORE*, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada and the laws of the United States, it is hereby ordered as follows:

The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all State public buildings and grounds on Thursday, May 3, 2012, in honor of the Nevada Peace Officers killed in the line of duty, including Deputy Sheriff Jack D. London, Special Agent Don C. Ware and Correctional Officer Tracy A. Hardin.
