



Executive Order 2012-20

ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS, today marks the anniversary of the devastating attacks on our nation at Pearl Harbor, December 7, 1941;

WHEREAS, many Nevadans sacrificed heroically at Pearl Harbor and throughout World War II;

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to honor the sacrifice of those civilians and servicemen who acted in the service of this country during the war; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada and the United States, I hereby direct and order:

The flags of the United States and the state of Nevada shall be flown at half staff at the State Capitol and all State public buildings and grounds today, December 7, 2012, until sundown.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Nevada to be affixed at the State Capitol in Carson City, this seventh day of December, in the year two thousand twelve.
