ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2013 President Barack Obama issued a proclamation declaring November 22, 2013 as a day of remembrance for President John F. Kennedy;

WHEREAS, John F. Kennedy's life was tragically cut short 50 years ago tomorrow;

WHEREAS, the state encourages all Nevadans to observe a moment of silence and school children to learn about the legacy of President John F. Kennedy;


WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The Supreme Executive Power of this State shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:




