



**Executive Order 2014-05**

**ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF**

**WHEREAS**, on March 1, 2014, a pilot engaged in a military training exercise near the Naval Air Station Fallon, suffered a fatal crash while engaged in combat training;

**WHEREAS**, our state recognizes our service men and women who, on a daily basis, demonstrate their dedication, commitment and sacrifice to our great nation;

**WHEREAS**, this service member has left behind family, friends and associates who will greatly mourn this loss of life;

**WHEREAS**, on March 1, 2014, this service member made the ultimate sacrifice for our country and it is appropriate to acknowledge and honor this sacrifice; and

**WHEREAS**, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The supreme executive power of this State, shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

**NOW, THEREFORE**, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada and the United States, I hereby direct and order:

The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half staff at the State Capitol and all military facilities, military posts and state public buildings and grounds beginning Tuesday, March 4, 2014 at sunrise, until Thursday, March 6, 2014 at sunset.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Nevada to be affixed at the State Capitol in Carson City, this third day of March, in the year two thousand fourteen.
