



Executive Order 2014-10

ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers throughout our State serve the citizens of Nevada with honor and distinction on a daily basis;

WHEREAS, the week of May 11, 2014, has been designated as National Police Week;

WHEREAS, on Thursday, May 1, 2014, in conjunction with National Police Week, the 17th Annual Nevada Law Enforcement Officers Memorial ceremony will be held on the Capitol grounds in Carson City to recognize the ultimate sacrifice our officers have made in service to our communities;

WHEREAS, the service will honor the 126 Nevada Peace Officers who have been killed in the line of duty since 1861, including Officer David Lee Vanbuskirk from the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, Watchman John Montague from the Southern Pacific Railroad Police, and Watchman Jose Sancebo from the Southern Pacific Railroad Police; and


WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The supreme executive power of the State, shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada and the laws of the United States, it is hereby ordered as follows:

The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all state public buildings and grounds on Thursday, May 1, 2014, in honor of the Nevada Peace Officers killed in the line of duty, including Officer David Lee Vanbuskirk, Watchman John Montague and Watchman Jose Sancebo.




