



Executive Order 2014-15

ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS, the dedicated men and women of the law enforcement community, throughout Nevada and the nation, put themselves in harm's way to preserve freedom and protect the safety and security of others;

WHEREAS, while many of Nevada's law enforcement professionals put themselves at risk daily, too many throughout our state have made the ultimate sacrifice for the greater good;

WHEREAS, on Sunday, June 8, 2014, Officers Alyn Beck and Igor Soldo of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, along with an innocent bystander, were tragically killed in a senseless attack;

WHEREAS, Officer Beck leaves behind a wife and three daughters, and Officer Soldo leaves behind a wife and a baby, and in addition to their families, friends and colleagues who will mourn their profound loss;

WHEREAS, the thoughts and prayers of all Nevadans go out to the victims of this tragedy and their families, and their sacrifices and memories should be honored; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides that, "The supreme executive power of this State, shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada and the United States, it is hereby ordered as follows:

The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all state public buildings and grounds on Monday, June 9, 2014 until sunset on Friday, June 13, 2014.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Nevada to be affixed at the State Capitol in Carson City, this 9th day of June in the year two thousand fourteen.
