



**Executive Order 2015-07**

**ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF-STAFF**

**WHEREAS**, the men and women of the United States military have selflessly placed themselves in peril throughout our nation's history, from the shores of Normandy to the deserts of Kuwait, to protect the lives of others and defend our nation;

**WHEREAS**, the State of Nevada was born during a time of war and this year marks 150 years since 1865 and the end of the Civil War;

**WHEREAS**, this year marks 70 years since 1945 and the end of World War II;

**WHEREAS**, this year marks 40 years since 1975 and the end of the Vietnam War;

**WHEREAS**, the President of the United States has proclaimed Memorial Day, May 25, 2015, as a day of prayer and peace to remember those men and women who have fallen in service to our nation;

**WHEREAS**, the President of the United States has designated 11:00 a.m. of that day as a time to unite in prayer and has further asked all Americans to observe the National Moment of Remembrance beginning at 3:00 p.m. local time on Memorial Day;

**WHEREAS**, the President of the United States has requested Governors of the United States and the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to direct the flag of the United States be flown at half-staff until noon on Memorial Day; and


**WHEREAS**, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides: "The supreme executive power of this State, shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

**NOW, THEREFORE**, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada and the United States, it is hereby ordered as follows:


The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all State public buildings and grounds on Monday, May 25, 2015, from sunrise until noon on that same day.


