



Executive Order 2015-13

ORDERING FLAGS TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS, the dedicated men and women of the law enforcement community throughout Nevada put themselves in harm's way each day to serve and protect others;

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2015, Carson City Sheriff's Deputy Carl Howell was tragically killed in the line of duty while serving and protecting the residents of Carson City;

WHEREAS, Deputy Howell was a husband and a father;

WHEREAS, the thoughts and prayers of Nevadans are with his family, friends, the Carson City Sheriff's Office, and the entire law enforcement community; and


WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides: "The supreme executive power of this State, shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as the Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:


The flags of the United States and the State of Nevada shall be flown at half-staff at the State Capitol and all State public buildings and grounds from Sunday, August 16, 2015, through Saturday, August 22, 2015, from sunrise to sunset, in honor and remembrance of the sacrifice and service of Deputy Howell.


