

Executive Order 2015-10

ORDER WITHDRAWING EXECUTIVE ORDER 2015-02

WHEREAS, Executive Order 2015-02 was issued on January 5, 2015, establishing the Governor's Business Roundtable for Education Policy Reform, which is tasked with identifying and developing recommendations on ways to reform K-12 education in this State, improve curriculum and instruction, and more efficiently allocate public funding;

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 421 was signed on June 8, 2015, establishing the Spending and Government Efficiency Commission, which is tasked with identifying and developing recommendations on ways to reduce costs for K-12 education in this State, increase efficiency, and improve the education system;

WHEREAS, the objectives and goals of the Governor's Business Roundtable for Education Policy Reform set forth in Executive Order 2015-02 and the Spending and Government Efficiency Commission set forth in Assembly Bill 421 are duplicative;

WHEREAS, the resources of the State are best served if efforts to develop recommendations on K-12 education reform are not redundant; and


WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides: "The supreme executive power of this State, shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. Executive Order 2015-02 is withdrawn.


