



## Executive Order 2015-32

### ORDER RE-ESTABLISHING THE NEVADA HOMELAND SECURITY WORKING GROUP

**WHEREAS**, the Nevada Homeland Security Working Group was created by an Executive Order issued on March 3, 2008, and amended by Executive Order 2011-31 issued on December 15, 2011;

**WHEREAS**, the Nevada Homeland Security Working Group serves an important role to the State of Nevada and should continue;

**WHEREAS**, the Nevada Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Management is the State Administrative Agency designated by me on behalf of the State of Nevada as it relates to all United States Department of Homeland Security grant programs; and

**WHEREAS**, Article 5, Section 1 of the Nevada Constitution provides: "The supreme executive power of this State, shall be vested in a Chief Magistrate who shall be Governor of the State of Nevada."

**NOW, THEREFORE**, by the authority vested in me as the Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Nevada, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. The Nevada Homeland Security Working Group (Working Group) is hereby re-established.
2. The Working Group shall ensure statewide collaboration in the development and implementation of security and emergency management preparedness initiatives.
3. The Working Group shall act as an advisory body to the Nevada Commission on Homeland Security through the Chief of the Division of Emergency Management.
4. The Chief of the Division of Emergency Management shall serve as the State Administrative Agent (SAA) on behalf of the State of Nevada and shall serve as the Working Group's representative to the Nevada Homeland Security Commission.
5. The Chief of the Division of Emergency Management shall serve as the Co-Chair of the Working Group and shall invite the Urban Area Administrator or his or her designee to serve as the other Co-Chair.
6. Members of the Working Group shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Governor and shall consist of not more than thirty-five (35) voting members. Members shall include representatives of the following entities:
  - a. Carson City;
  - b. City of Henderson;
  - c. City of Las Vegas;
  - d. City of North Las Vegas;
  - e. City of Reno;
  - f. Clark County;
  - g. Clark County School District;
  - h. Elko County;
  - i. Inter-Tribal Council;
  - j. Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department;
  - k. Lyon County;
  - l. Nevada Department of Administration;

- m. Nevada Department of Health and Human Services;
- n. Nevada Department of Public Safety;
- o. Nevada Department of Transportation;
- p. Nevada Hospital Association;
- q. North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District;
- r. Northeastern Nevada;
- s. Nevada National Guard;
- t. NV Energy;
- u. Regional Transportation Commission (Northern Nevada);
- v. Regional Transportation Commission (Southern Nevada);
- w. Southeastern Nevada;
- x. Southern Nevada Health District;
- y. Storey County;
- z. Washoe County;
- aa. Washoe County School District;
- bb. Washoe County Sheriff's Office;
- cc. Western Nevada;
- dd. White Pine County; and
- ee. Any other member as determined necessary by the Governor.

7. Members of the Working Group shall receive no compensation for their service.
8. The Working Group shall deliver a report to the Governor on or before June 30 and December 31 each year detailing its activities.
9. The Working Group may establish procedural bylaws to aid it in the performance of its duties to be approved by the Commission on Homeland Security.
10. The Working Group may establish subcommittee(s) comprised of members of the Working Group to aid in the performance of its duties.
11. The Working Group shall meet at the discretion and direction of the Chief of the Division of Emergency Management.
12. The Nevada Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Management shall provide administrative support to the Working Group.
13. All records documenting the Working Group's activities shall be retained and transferred to the State Archives for retention in accordance with the State record retention policy.
14. The Working Group shall cease to exist on December 31, 2018.
