WHEREAS, agencies like the Las Vegas Urban League, a Community Action Agency have made an essential contribution to individuals and families in the state of Nevada, by providing them with innovative and cost-effective programs; and

WHEREAS, welfare reform in Nevada has benefited from the state's partnership with community action agencies; and

WHEREAS, people existing below the poverty level are on the increase in Nevada and continue to need opportunities to improve their lives and their living conditions, thus ensuring that all citizens are able to live in dignity; and

WHEREAS, Nevada and the entire United States must continue to promote economic security by providing support and opportunities for all citizens in need of assistance;
