



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, David A. Millman entered service with the State of Nevada as an attendant and indexer at the Nevada Historical Society's Las Vegas office in September 1983; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Millman was promoted to Curator III, History at the Nevada State Museum & Historical Society in August 1985 and served in this capacity until promoted to Museum Director III on July 1, 2007; and

WHEREAS, overcoming significant financial shortfalls and demonstrating exceptional dedication and an abundance of skill and leadership, a new 70,000 square-foot state-of-the-art museum was constructed and opened on the campus of the Las Vegas Springs Preserve, to be enjoyed by generations of Nevadans and visitors; and
