**WHEREAS**, Christie Cohen is consistently willing to accept extra duties from provisioning systems security to maintaining system-generated forms and system tables; and


**WHEREAS**, Christie Cohen has always demonstrated professionalism, quality, flexibility, adaptability and dependability in her everyday work for the agency; and


