



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, in 1912 the City of Las Vegas experienced tremendous growth in producing small ranches, mining in Potosi and the South Nevada Gold Mining company as well as over 100 flowing wells and developing agriculture farms; and

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas established railroads and other infrastructure to meet the needs of the growing population which created a further need to address issues and grievances in court; and

WHEREAS, the creation of the Municipal Courts provided a legal service to businesses and residents of Las Vegas thereby establishing a committed legal community to further benefit the city residents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas in 1912 established its Municipal Courts and other municipal offices to provide services to the booming population of Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, this year will mark 100 years since the inception of the Las Vegas Municipal Courts;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim August 7, 2012 as a day in honor of the

CENTENNIAL OF THE LAS VEGAS MUNICIPAL COURTS
