
WHEREAS, Shirley has demonstrated professionalism, skill, loyalty and patience, while also providing excellent customer service to the clients she served through the years; and


WHEREAS, Shirley will be sincerely missed by her co-workers and friends who extend their deepest gratitude and congratulations as she embarks on a prosperous retirement;
