



## *A Proclamation by the Governor*

**WHEREAS**, the Nevada Area Council of the Boy Scouts of America was chartered in 1924 and covers 25 counties in Northern Nevada and northeastern California, spanning over 139,000 square miles and serving over 13,000 young men and women with over 3,400 adult volunteer leaders; and

**WHEREAS**, the mission of the Boy Scouts of America is to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetime by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Scout Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Scout Oath declares that "on my honor I will do my best, To do my duty to God and my country, and to obey the Scout Law; To help other people at all times; To keep myself physically strong, mentally awake and morally straight;" and

**WHEREAS**, the Scout Law declares that "a Scout is trustworthy, Loyal, Helpful, Friendly, Courteous, Kind, Obedient, Cheerful, Thrifty, Brave, Clean, and Reverent;" and

**WHEREAS**, the Good Scout Award seeks to begin a tradition of honoring community members who have made a positive impact through leadership and service that exemplify the principles of the Scout Oath and Scout Law; and

**WHEREAS**, Reno Mayor Robert Cashell has given of his time and talents to make the Northern Nevada community a better place and he is being honored with the 2012 Good Scout Award;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim October 3, 2012 as a day in honor of**
