WHEREAS, Nevada encourages motorists to drive safely, not just during the holiday season, but every time they get behind the wheel; and

WHEREAS, the Sunday after Thanksgiving is the busiest highway travel day of the year; and


WHEREAS, there is no single day set aside in the U.S. for everyone to focus on driving more safely; and


