WHEREAS, Miranda Du left Vietnam with her family by boat when she was just eight years old and lived in refugee camps in Malaysia before she came to America with her family when she was almost 10; and

WHEREAS, Miranda Du earned a Bachelor's degree in history and economics from the University of California, Davis before graduating from the University of California, Berkeley – Boalt Hall School of Law and joining the law firm of McDonald Carano Wilson in 1994; and

WHEREAS, Du was named a partner in 2002 and grew to be a strong leader within the firm, including serving as chair of the firm's Employment & Labor Law Practice Group; and

WHEREAS, while working as a dedicated lawyer, Du also remained active in the Nevada community, serving in recent years as a board member of the Nevada Women's Fund and a member of the Nevada Commission on Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, Miranda has exhibited great character and is well respected in the legal community and will make a great addition to the federal bench in Nevada;
