



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, TRIO programs are funded under Title IV of the Higher Education Action of 1965 and were initially just three programs. While student financial aid programs help students overcome financial aid barriers to higher education, TRIO programs help students overcome class, social, and cultural barriers to higher education; and

WHEREAS, TRIO programs are federally funded by the U.S. Department of Education. The programs identify qualified disadvantaged youth or adults who are low-income and/or first-generation college students. Participants are selected according to their potential for academic success; and

WHEREAS, TRIO Programs within the State of Nevada include Educational Talent Search; Upward Bound Programs; Veterans Upward Bound; Educational Opportunity Centers; Student Support Services; Ronald E. McNair Baccalaureate Program, research and administrative careers in higher education; and

WHEREAS, in Nevada in 2014 there are 23 Federal TRIO Programs assisting 4,981 students at a cost of \$6,247,990. There are 5 institutions of higher education hosting TRIO Programs in Nevada; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim February 22, 2014, as

“NATIONAL TRIO DAY”
