WHEREAS, 1 in 4,400 Nevadans have hypoparathyroidism; and

WHEREAS, hypoparathyroidism is a rare medical disorder that affects less than 100,000 Americans, but is growing at an alarming rate due to an increase in thyroid cancer and parathyroid surgeries; and

WHEREAS, hypoparathyroidism is a serious medical condition that is debilitating and has a serious impact on the lives of those affected; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Hypoparathyroidism Association is to educate the public and the medical community about hypoparathyroidism; and

WHEREAS, the Hypoparathyroidism Association, Inc. is organizing a statewide observance of Hypoparathyroidism Awareness Day on June 1, 2014, where patients, medical professionals, researchers, government officials and pharmaceutical companies are joining together to focus attention on the woefully misunderstood and misdiagnosed medical disorder;

THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim June 1, 2014, as
