WHEREAS, David G. Miller started his service to the State of Nevada as a Programmer/Analyst with the Department of Data Processing on September, 28, 1985; and

WHEREAS, David subsequently became a Data Processing Planning Analyst on November 2, 1989; and

WHEREAS, David transferred to the Mental Health Division with responsibility for IT and Program Evaluation on December 6, 1993; and

WHEREAS, David missed planning so much that he returned to the Department of Information Technology Planning section on May 22, 2000, where he created his legacy, the Technology Investment Request, or TIR, process, for the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, David survived multiple organizational changes and expansions and contractions of the DoIT (now Enterprise IT Services) Planning function, including several years where the Planning "Unit" consisted of a "Unit" of one, Mr. Miller; and

WHEREAS, David will retire from the state on August 14, 2014, after more than 28 years of service to the citizens of the State of Nevada;
