WHEREAS, Norm was a support programmer for the Department of Taxation and co-programmed the Nevada Business Tax System, Taxi Cab Authority, Risk Management, Real Estate and Budget office, and

WHEREAS, Norm was lead programmer for the State Personnel and Payroll Legacy system, Y2K conversion to the Advantage HR system, NEATS and HR Data Warehouse, and

WHEREAS, Norm transferred to the Department of Corrections in 2006 to work on the NOTIS project where he rose to the position of Information Systems Manager II, and

WHEREAS, Norm transferred to DETR in 2012, returning to his roots of application development. He supported the OSOS, Financial Management and RAISON applications. While at DETR his largest project was the Paperless RAISON project which was implemented in 2013, and

WHEREAS, on behalf of Norm's co-workers and the citizens of the State of Nevada, we thank and commend Norm for his 30 years of outstanding service to our Silver State and wish him continued success in all his future endeavors;
