



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, the Signers Chapter, Nevada Society, Sons of the American Revolution was organized and established on September 15, 1964; and

WHEREAS, through patriotic, historical, and educational activities, the Signers Chapter, Nevada Society, Sons of the American Revolution perpetuates in Southern Nevada the memory of the Patriots of the American Revolutionary War who achieved the independence of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the Signers Chapter, Nevada Society, Sons of the American Revolution, celebrates its 50th anniversary in 2014;
