



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, the Act entitled "An Act to Establish the Judicial Courts of the United States," was signed into law by President George Washington on September 24, 1789. The Act, passed by the First United States Congress, directed the appointment of United States Marshals and launched the United States Marshals Service; and

WHEREAS, the United States Marshals Service is the nation's oldest and most versatile law enforcement agency; and

WHEREAS, the United States Marshals Service is a federal law enforcement agency within the United States Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, during 225 years of service, United States Marshals have executed warrants, distributed presidential proclamations, registered enemy aliens in time of war, helped conduct the national census, protected the President and the federal courts, provided for the custody and transportation of federal prisoners, managed and disposed of seized and forfeited assets, ensured the safe conduct of judicial proceedings, protected federal judges, jurors and other members of the federal judiciary, provided for the security of witnesses, operated the federal Witness Protection Program, conducted criminal investigations into violations of federal and state laws, and directed and coordinated taskforces in order to apprehend fugitives throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, the men and women of the United States Marshals Service have served the Nation and State of Nevada valiantly with an unwavering dedication to justice, integrity, and service;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim September 24, 2014, as
