



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, Charlene Herst began her career in state government at the Nevada State Health Division as the Tobacco Program Manager on October 8, 2001. In June 2006, she was promoted to Health Program Manager II of the Chronic Disease Program and in 2009 accepted the position as Health Program Manager II at the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Agency as Prevention Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, Charlene Herst dedicated her career to the area of prevention and improving the lives of Nevada's citizens by her work in reducing heart disease and stroke, reducing the use of tobacco products, especially among youth, and was instrumental in the implementation of the Nevada Clean Indoor Act after passage in 2006, improving prevention services to women, and reducing the rate of substance use and abuse in Nevada; and

WHEREAS, Charlene Herst served under Governors Kenny Guinn, Jim Gibbons, and Brian Sandoval; and

WHEREAS, the leadership provided by Charlene Herst improved job performance by guiding, encouraging, and supporting staff in a professional and caring manner; and


WHEREAS, the accomplishments of Charlene Herst over her thirteen years of service have made a significant difference for many Nevadans;
