WHEREAS, public awareness of sudden cardiac arrest incidence and treatment leads to early intervention and lives saved; and

WHEREAS, AED/CPR training benefit all members of a community by empowering people to help people; and

WHEREAS, Nevada celebrates its 150th birthday this year and Nevada Project Heartbeat is proud to be part of making Nevada a great place to live, visit, and raise families;
