**WHEREAS**, Joseph "Joe" M. Hogan was born August 10, 1937, in Fort Dodge, Iowa, and devoted his life to the service of his country as a veteran of America's armed forces, as a federal official, and as a dedicated state legislator; and

**WHEREAS**, Joe, a graduate of Notre Dame and the Georgetown University Law Center, was also a proud family man and husband, the father of three children, Kathleen, Michael, and David, and grandfather of five grandchildren; and

**WHEREAS**, Joe exemplified an honorable commitment to service above self throughout his professional career with the federal government, first as an officer in the United States Navy, and later as a program manager for the United States Department of Labor and as a contracting officer for the United States Department of Defense and National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA); and

**WHEREAS**, Joe was elected five times by the people of the state of Nevada to represent Assembly District 10, a position he held from 2005 until his passing on October 17, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, in his role as a Nevada State Assemblyman, Joe faithfully and dutifully represented his constituents, fervently and passionately advocated on behalf of the ideals in which he believed, meaningfully contributed to the political process in Nevada, and displayed commendable leadership as a legislator; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to his public service as a state lawmaker, Joe was actively involved in efforts to improve his community, working diligently as a civil rights attorney and as a member of multiple public interest organizations including the National Urban League, the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU), The Nature Conservancy, The League of Women Voters and as a staunch advocate for Alzheimer's Disease Research; and




