**WHEREAS**, drivers should prepare themselves for the unpredictable behaviors of other drivers, disabled vehicles, spilled cargo, adverse weather conditions, and many other potential dangers that they may encounter on roadways, remaining focused in order to react quickly and appropriately in such situations; and

**WHEREAS**, it is always important for drivers to focus on driving, to eliminate distractions, to maintain safe speeds, and to drive defensively to avoid preventable accidents; and

**WHEREAS**, many individuals and organizations in Nevada are working tirelessly to increase awareness of the critical need for driver safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sunday after the Thanksgiving holiday is traditionally the busiest highway travel day of the year;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim November 30, 2014, as**
