



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2014, Katherine Anderson is retiring from the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services after more than 22 years of loyal, diligent, and exceptional public service to the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, Katherine began her professional career with the State of Nevada on May 11, 1992, as an Eligibility Certification Specialist for the Welfare Division, and was promoted to the position of Eligibility Supervisor of the Seamless Food Stamp/Medical Unit in the Henderson District Office in April 2001; and

WHEREAS, Katherine continued her career with the Welfare Division at the Henderson District Office until April 2007, at which time she was promoted to District Office Manager of the Flamingo District Office. In January 2010 Kathy became the District Office Manager of the Owens District Office; and

WHEREAS, Katherine has served under four Nevada Governors, Bob Miller, Kenny Guinn, Jim Gibbons, and Brian Sandoval, as well as eight Welfare Administrators, Linda Ryan, Myla C. Ford, Romaine Gilliland, Diane Comeaux, Mike McMahon, and Steve Fisher, and has supervised, trained and mentored hundreds of case managers, eligibility supervisors, lead workers, and administrative assistants; and

Through her service to her fellow citizens, she is able to leave her position with dignity knowing that she has made a difference in our community.
