WHEREAS, Stephen A. vonRumpf began his career with the State of Nevada on September 11, 1995, with the Department of Public Safety, in the Investigation Division as a Criminal Investigator I, assigned to the Major Crimes Unit; and

WHEREAS, Stephen A. vonRumpf will officially retire December 12, 2014, as a Criminal Investigator III/Polygrapher; and


WHEREAS, colleagues wish Stephen A. vonRumpf all the best in his retirement and future endeavors;
