WHEREAS, Paul H. Hinen enlisted in the Nevada Air National Guard in June 1983, and has served continuously for over 31 years; and

WHEREAS, Paul has deployed multiple times in support of Domestic Emergencies within Nevada as well as abroad; to include Hurricane Katrina relief operations to New Orleans, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, Paul has deployed for multiple contingency operations to support the Global War on Terrorism to include Qatar, Kyrgyzstan, and Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS, Paul became employed with the State of Nevada and the Nevada Highway Patrol on January 12, 1987; and

WHEREAS, Paul trained countless Law Enforcement Officers within Nevada while serving as Training Officer, Deputy Commander of the Nevada Law Enforcement academy, and Commander for the Nevada Highway Patrol Specialized Academy; and

WHEREAS, Paul served as a Traffic Accident Reconstructionist, serving on Major Accident Investigation Teams in both Reno and Elko, commanding the Reno Major Accident Investigation Team; and

WHEREAS, Paul coordinated Homeland Security Grants, which resulted in the award of nearly \$4 million dollars for the Nevada Department of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, Paul volunteered many years' service with the Boy Scouts of America, the American Red Cross, the American Youth Soccer Organization, and Little League Baseball, not including numerous other charitable organizations; and

WHEREAS, Paul currently serves as the Executive Director of the non-profit International Goodwill Ambassador's Inner Circle, promoting relationships with Nevada and foreign dignitaries; and

WHEREAS, Paul celebrates his 50th Birthday on January 22, 2015, and recently reached a concurrent 50 years of service to Nevadan's with 19 years at Nevada Highway Patrol and 31 years at the Nevada Air National Guard;
