WHEREAS, the alarming number of workplace injuries and illnesses to the Hispanic workforce calls for a greater emphasis on the importance of safe working procedures; and

WHEREAS, promoting safety through constant diligence and attention to risks in the workplace, employers and employees may be instrumental in the efforts of providing a safe working environment; and

WHEREAS, the State of Nevada commends all those involved in this effort to provide and encourage safe working environments for Nevada's workforce; and

WHEREAS, a month long effort to observe safety in the workplace that will express the need we all must have for appropriate safety procedures on a job in our State;
