**WHEREAS**, Carla Sloan has dedicated her career to ensuring a better quality of life for older Nevadans; and

**WHEREAS**, she has spent more than 30 years as a leading voice for access to essential services and legal protections for seniors across the state, in local communities and at the state legislature; and

**WHEREAS**, as founding director of the Howard W. Cannon Senior Services Center, and as Senior Services coordinator for the Las Vegas Housing Authority, for nearly a decade she designed and implemented model supportive services programs to help seniors in public housing live more independently; and

**WHEREAS**, as administrator for the State of Nevada's Division for Aging Services, she led a statewide network of public and private community and senior organizations, ensuring Federal and state-funded programs addressed critical needs for access to health care, housing and social services; and

**WHEREAS**, she has represented the interests of Nevada seniors as an expert advocate and resource on community, state and national boards, including the Governor's Commission on Aging, Nevada Legislative Task Force for a Healthy Nevada, University of Nevada Las Vegas Center for Aging and Nevada Elder Abuse Prevention Council; and

**WHEREAS**, as the founding Nevada state director for AARP, she has for 16 years cultivated a strong voice for older Nevadans on Federal, state and local issues, and developed programs linking thousands to resources for health security, financial resilience and personal fulfillment; and

**WHEREAS**, over the course of her career, Carla has not only advanced the cause of seniors in Nevada and across the nation, but has also been personally responsible for programs touching many thousands of real lives – helping older adults live healthier, happier and more independent lives;
