



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, Jeffery F. Figueiredo began his service with the Nevada Department of Public Safety on February 27, 1995, as a cadet with the Nevada Highway Patrol, and that on July 7, 1995, following his successful completion of the Nevada Peace Officers' Standards and Training Basic Academy and the Nevada Highway Patrol Specifics Academy, Jeff Figueiredo earned the title of State Trooper, and began his first assignment in Las Vegas, Nevada; and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 1998, Jeff Figueiredo transferred from his duty assignment with NHP Southern Command in Las Vegas, Nevada, to NHP Northern Command West in Reno, Nevada, where he worked various assignments to include traffic operations, Dignitary Protection Detail, and Commercial Vehicle Enforcement; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2001, FBI Supervisory Senior Resident Agent Jerry Hill recognized Jeff Figueiredo for the actions which Jeff Figueiredo took on Sunday, December 10, 2000, while on patrol as a State Trooper in Reno, Nevada. During this time, Jeff Figueiredo's actions led to the location and apprehension of bank robbery suspect Brent David Muir, whom the FBI had identified as an extremely dangerous fugitive; and

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2006, Jeff Figueiredo transferred to the DPS Investigation Division where he became a Detective assigned to the Special Investigations Unit. During this time, Jeff Figueiredo's investigative assignments included the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Joint Terrorism Task Force in Reno, Nevada, the Nevada Threat Analysis Center (NTAC)—the State of Nevada's Fusion Center in Carson City—the Major Crimes Unit, the All Threats All Crimes Task Force (ATAC), the Tri-Net Narcotics Task Force, and the Fraud Unit; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Figueiredo has also served the State of Nevada with pride and distinction as an officer in the Nevada Army National Guard, and that his service to the State of Nevada has involved active duty deployment as part of Operation Enduring Freedom; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Figueiredo officially retired as a Detective with the Nevada Department of Public Safety, Investigation Division on March 9, 2015, following twenty years of dedicated service to the citizens of the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, the State of Nevada and the Nevada Department of Public Safety wish to publicly acknowledge Jeff Figueiredo for the dedication, pride, and service that he has given to the citizens of this great State;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN SANDOVAL, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, do hereby proclaim April 20, 2015, as a day in honor of

JEFFERY F. FIGUEIREDO
