WHEREAS, millions of Americans will experience the joys of bicycling during May through educational and safety programs, community events, or just getting out and going for a ride; and

WHEREAS, May has been declared National Bike Month for each of the last 59 years; and

WHEREAS, the State of Nevada commends all the participants of Nevada Bike Week and encourages all participants to remember to observe all safety measures, including wearing a helmet and obeying all traffic laws;
