



A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, the National Center for Learning Disabilities has released findings that 1 in 5 individuals worldwide are burdened by some form of dyslexia; and

WHEREAS, Jobs for Dyslexics and countless organizations across the United States have initiated efforts to raise awareness and mobilize support and activism for greater opportunities and success for dyslexic adults in the workplace; and

WHEREAS, Jobs for Dyslexics believes that, by establishing indispensable lines of communication between dyslexic individuals, academic institutions, employers in both the public and private sectors, and the larger community in Nevada and beyond, American business can gain a global edge by capitalizing on otherwise unrealized and untapped talent; and

WHEREAS, on the date below, Jobs For Dyslexics, the Nevada Governor's Council on Developmental Disabilities, and the City of Reno are sponsoring an anniversary celebration of the signing of the Americans with Disabilities Act 25 years ago and will be commemorating it with forums, roundtables, information dissemination, and presentations celebrating achievements and sharing visions for a brighter future for dyslexics in the American workplace;
